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I HEREBY REQUEST A HEARING FOR THE PURPOSE OF: (Check Only One Box)

IMPLIED CONSENT ACT- Contesting the revocation of my driver's license and/or driving privileges based on violation of the Implied Consent Act: Refusal to submit to the breath/blood test; failure of breath/blood test, blood alcohol content (BAC) at or above .08 (or BAC at or above .02 for persons less than 21 years of age, or at or above .04 if the person was driving a commercial motor vehicle). **Request must be submitted or postmarked within ten (10) days from the date of receipt of notice of revocation and must include an Administrative Hearing Fee of \$25.00 or a sworn Statement of Indigency (form MVD-10813).**

CHILD SUPPORT- Contesting the suspension of my driver's license for failure to comply with child support payments under the Parental Responsibility Act. (No hearing fee required.)

LIMITED LICENSE FOR WORK OR SCHOOL- Applying for a Limited License (for work, school or court ordered treatment). If you are revoked for an Implied Consent revocation, first offense, and you submitted to a blood or breath test, you will need to provide proof of enrollment/completion of DWI school and alcohol screening. (No hearing fee required, see instructions on reverse.)

INTERLOCK LICENSE- Applying for an Ignition Interlock License. (No hearing fee required, see instructions on reverse.)

*** DWI CRIMINAL CONVICTION(S)-** Contesting the revocation of a New Mexico driver's license and/or driving privileges based on DWI conviction(s). (No hearing fee required)

*** POINTS SUSPENSION-** Contesting the suspension of a New Mexico driver's license and/or driving privileges based on the accumulation of twelve (12) or more points assessed as a result of traffic violation convictions. (No hearing fee required)

** These are not "in person" hearings. MVD will review the documents upon which it based the action to confirm the proper action was taken against the proper person.*

Difference Between Limited License and Ignition Interlock License

In 2003, the New Mexico Legislature passed a law making it possible for certain persons whose licenses are revoked to choose between obtaining either a Limited License or an Ignition Interlock License. This short explanation is to help you understand the difference between a Limited License and an Ignition Interlock License, so you can tell us which one you would like to apply for.

LIMITED LICENSE

A Limited License is available to persons whose licenses have been revoked for a violation of the Implied Consent Act. It is available for a person who submitted to the blood or breath test and has no prior Implied Consent revocations. The Limited License is good ONLY for the limited purposes of driving to and from work, for work-related purposes, school, and court-ordered treatment programs.

A person who submitted to the blood or breath test and has no prior Implied Consent revocations can choose to obtain an Ignition Interlock License instead of a Limited License.

IGNITION INTERLOCK LICENSE

An Ignition Interlock License is available to persons whose driver licenses have been revoked for any Implied Consent violation – first offense, subsequent offense or a refusal - and it is available to any persons whose license is revoked or denied for a DWI conviction. This license requires that you have an approved ignition interlock device installed in any vehicle you will be driving. These devices are available from several suppliers and require that you pay an installation fee and a monthly rental fee, but the license is otherwise unrestricted

REQUIREMENTS

Both the Limited License and the Ignition Interlock License require a \$45.00 license fee and each requires that you submit documentation to MVD confirming your identity and showing that you are insured. A person who submitted to the blood or breath test and has no prior Implied Consent revocations must serve the first thirty days of the revocation period without any type of license.

Additionally, the Limited License requires proof that you are working, attending school, or court-ordered to a treatment program.

The Ignition Interlock License requires that you submit a notarized affidavit (provided by MVD) stating that you understand the conditions of this license.
